

Memo. - Taken from the Field Notes of the County line between Walden & Medina Counties, as run by Wm. Mylius Surveyor from Medina Co. and J. C. Munnings Surveyor from Walden Co. in December 1858 - the S.W. corner of Medina Co. having been come at by running the lines of Medina Co. from its beginning on the Medina River

Beginning at a stake the S.W. corner of Medina Co. & S.E. of Walden Co., distant 1500 varas S 31° 52' E. from the N.E. corner of Survey No. 371 (being South 1278 & East 792 v<sup>rs</sup>) in name of Luciano de la Garza - Thence North, at 240 v<sup>rs</sup> cross Rio Chico, at 31007 varas the N.E. corner of Survey No. 473 in name of D. Scott bears West 666 varas, at 32290 v<sup>rs</sup> cross Ran- chero Creek, at ~~42070~~ 44625, at 48070 and at 48590 varas cross a Prong of Ran- chero creek, at 52500 v<sup>rs</sup> cross a West Prong of Seco creek, at 66345 v<sup>rs</sup> cross Main Seco, at 67094 v<sup>rs</sup> the N.W. corner of Survey No. 487 in name of G. Morgan, and S.W. of 488 in name of R. R. Flemming bears East 769 varas, at 68429 varas (30 miles) a Rock Mound on the side of a Round Mountain for N.W. corner of Medina Co. & N.E. of Walden Co. &c. &c. - This corner being North 1335 v<sup>rs</sup> & West 769 v<sup>rs</sup> from the aforesaid corner of Surveys

No. 487 & 488

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I suppose the field notes of the above  
named lines will arrive, officially, at  
the Genl Sd Office, in due course of time.  
They were run by surveyors legally appointed,  
the field notes not yet examined & passed  
upon by the respective County Courts.
