County appointed by the County Commis-
sioners of Garza County to mark and
run the line between the Counties of
Waukegan and Garza to wit: the
County line between the South East

Corner of Waldo County and the South West Corner of said Waldo County having returned and filed field notes and maps of said survey as made by them and the Court after due inspection thereof being of opinion that said survey has been fairly made and made according to the law relating thereto, It is ordered by the Court that said survey the field notes and map thereof be recored approved and in all things confirmed and that the same be recorded by the Clerk.

Plat and field notes of the South line of Waldo County and the North line of Zaralla County as run by J. M. Bennett Deputy County Surveyor of Waldo County and Ab. Luce County Surveyor of Zaralla County in accordance with an order of the Honorable County Commissioners Courts of said Counties, Beginning October the 13th A.
