

Field Notes of a Re Survey of the boundary
line between Hunt and Van Zandt Counties
as run by H. C. Manning for Van Zandt County
~~Septbr~~ 13 and 14th 1880 - And of the Boundary line
between Kaufman and Van Zandt Counties
as Re Surveyed by L. H. Bryant on the part
of Kaufman County and H. C. Manning
on the part of Van Zandt County on the
15, 16, 17 and 18th days of Septbr 1880.

Hunt and Van Zandt Line

Beginning in the Centre of the main channel
of the Sabine River at a Point where the
Hunt County line crossed it as run in the
year 1846. and 200 varas South of the North
boundary line of the Jacob D Rains 320
acre Survey and about 200 varas East
of the East boundary line of Said Jacob D Rains
Survey. Thence West along the boundary line of Hunt
County as run in 1846. at a variation of about
8° 30' East. At 1250 varas Trimble Lake ties
60 varas to the North at one mile set up
mile Post No. 1. at two miles set up mile
Post No. 2 at three miles set up mile Post No. 3
at four miles set up mile Post No. 4 at 460 varas a branch
runs N.E. at 810 varas branch runs N.E. at 1500 varas branch
runs North at 1690 varas branch runs N.E. at five miles
set up mile Post No. 5. at six miles set up mile Post
No. 6 at 1140 varas Pass old mile Post set up in

1846. at 1250 varas a branch runs West Cross
and Recross it several times at Seven Miles Set
up mile Post N.^o. 7 at 1210 varas pass old mile Post
set up in 1846. at 1420 varas Duck Creek runs
NE at Eight miles Set up mile Post N.^o. 8 at 20 varas.
Prairie at 588 varas Corner of Van Zandt and Kaufman
Counties in a small Prairie on the J. Roark
Survey whence a Post oak 16 inches in diameter marked
X and K bears S. 73° W. 38 varas and a Double Post oak 13
and 15 inches in diameter marked **X** and **V**. bear S. 43½° E.
62. varas This line is Eight miles and 588 varas
in length and runs at an acute angle cutting the
lines of the Land Surveys in its course. as will
be seen by reference to map or plot.

Kaufman and Van Zandt lines

Beginning at a mound and Post in small Prairie
in the J. Roark Survey from whence a Post oak 16.
inches in diameter marked **X** and K bears S. 73° W. 38 varas
and a Double Post oak 13 and 15 inches in diameter
bears S. 43½° E. 62. varas. marked **X** and **V**.

Thence South at a variation of 9° 10' East. at
2109½ varas set up mile Post N.^o. 1 at the old mile
post set up by R. A. Terrell in 1850. whence a
Post oak 20 inches in diameter marked K bears
S. 42½° W. 14. varas. at 3000. varas Duck Creek runs N.E.
at 4010. varas set up mile Post N.^o. 2 in a small
Prairie from whence a fallen Black Jack 12 inches

Diameter marked K by R. A. Terrell in 1850 bears N. 14° W. 12 varas at 5702 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas or three miles from beginning Set up mile Post No. 3 whence a Post oak 12 inches in diameter marked X and V bears S. 69° E. 12 varas a Post oak 16 inches in dia. marked X and K bears N 30° W 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas. at 3 miles 210 varas Pass Terrell old mile Post at 680 varas the East Corner of the D. Walling League Survey is 200 varas East of County line at 875 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^{varas} Cross S. E. B line of Walling League Survey at Five miles Set up mile Post No. 5 whence a Post oak 24 inches dia marked X and V bears S. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 6 $\frac{2}{5}$ varas at Six miles Set up mile Post No. 6 in Prairie at 147 varas the South Corner of the W. Gibbard Survey bears due west 324 varas distant at 1566 G. L. Tucker house on line at Seven miles Set up mile Post No. 7 in Prairie at Eight miles Set up mile Post No. 8 in Prairie at 8 miles and 1424 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^{varas} Cross the Texas and Pacific Railway at Nine miles Set up mile Post No. 9 in Prairie at Ten miles Set up mile Post No. 10 in Prairie at Eleven miles Set up mile Post No. 11 in Prairie at Twelve miles Set up mile Post No. 12 in Prairie at 13 miles Set up mile Post No. 13 on west side of Wolf Creek whence a double Post oak 10 and 15 inches diameters marked X and V bears S. 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 13 varas and a Black Jack marked X 12 inches dia bears S. 65° E. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas at 13 miles 180 varas Wolf Creek runs S. W. at 83.5 varas N. B. line of Frewett League of land at 14 miles Set up mile Post No. 14 a Red oak 24 inches diameter marked X and V. bears S. 14° E. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas

An Elm 18 inches dia. marked X and K bears S. 14° E. $4\frac{1}{2}$ Varas at 110 varas pass Terrells old Mile Post at 15 miles set up mile Post N. 15. whence a Post oak 24 inches dia marked X and V bears N. 21° E. $14\frac{1}{2}$ Varas a Hickory 24 inches marked X and K bears S. 31° W. 14 Varas at 112 varas Pass Terrells old Mile Post at 1120. varas Allens Creek runs S. W. at 16 miles set up mile Post N. 16 in Small Prairie at 1100 varas Wolf Creek runs S. E. at 1350 varas Cedar Creek runs S. E. at 17 miles set up mile Post N. 17 whence a pecan 24 inches dia marked X and K bears S. 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ Varas an Ash 20 inches dia marked X and V bears S. 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. $15\frac{1}{2}$ Varas at 90 varas cross another Cedar recross it at 260 varas and cross it again at 360 varas running East. at 18 miles set up mile Post N. 18 in small prairie whence a Post oak 24 inches dia marked X and V bears S. 1° E. 27 Varas at 950 Bowie Lake at 19 miles Set up mile Post N. 19. whence a Post oak marked X and V bears N. 17° W. $12\frac{1}{2}$ Varas a Post oak marked X and K bears N. 25° E. 17 Varas at 20 miles set up mile Post N. 20. whence a Post oak 20 inches dia marked X and K bears N. 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. $12\frac{1}{2}$ Varas a Locust 18 inches dia marked X and V bears N. 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. $9\frac{1}{2}$ Varas at 200 varas Cedar Creek runs S. W. at 1670 branch runs East at 21 miles set up mile Post N. 21. in Brush Prairie at 21 miles and 270 varas the N. S. line of the W. Y. Brewer League Survey at 22 miles

Set up mile Post N° 22 in Prairie at 23 miles
 Set up mile Post N° 23 in Prairie whence a Post
 oak 15 inches marked X and K bears $566\frac{2}{3}W$ 7 Varas
 a Post oak 15 inches marked X and V bears $N86\frac{1}{2}N$ 10 $\frac{3}{5}$ Varas
 at 24 miles Set up mile Post N° 24. in Prairie whence a
 bunch of Hackberries marked X. K and V bear South 56.
 Varas at 25 miles Set up mile Post N° 25 in the
 timber whence a Black Jack 20 inches dia marked
 X and V bears $N39\frac{1}{2}E$ 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ Varas a Post oak 24 inches
 dia marked X and K bears $S60\frac{1}{2}N$ 5. Varas at 1580
 Varas Lucy's Creek at 26 miles Set up mile Post
 N° 26. at 250 Varas Thomason's Lake at 27
 miles Set up mile Post N° 27 in a small
 Prairie at 28 miles Set up mile Post N° 28. at
 a Post Oak 30 inches dia marked X. V and K
 at 29 miles Set up mile Post N° 29 at a Post
 oak whence another Post Oak 24 inches dia
 bears East 10 Varas and marked X and V. at 30 miles
 Set up mile Post N° 30. in Prairie at 31 miles
 Set up mile Post N° 31 in Prairie at 32 miles
 Set up mile Post N° 32 in Prairie at 33 miles
 Set up mile Post N° 33 in Timber whence a Post
 oak 26 inches dia marked X and K bears $S43\frac{1}{2}N$
 11. Varas a Post oak 12 inches dia marked X.
 and V bears South $3\frac{1}{2}$ Varas at 33 miles and
 566 $\frac{2}{3}$ Varas Set up Post N° 34 at the corner
 of Van Zandt and Kaufman Counties on the
 North Line of Henderson County. whence
 a Post Oak 24 inches in diameter marked X and V

bears S $\frac{1}{2}$ E 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas a Post oak 24 inches
in diameter marked X and H bears S $\frac{1}{2}$ W.
14 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas a Post oak 24 inches dia marked
X and K bears S $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 8 varas another Post
oak 24 inches near the last marked X, V, K, H.
thus showing the length of this line to be 33.
miles 566 $\frac{1}{3}$ varas.
