

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
Dear Sir and Friend:

I am in receipt of a copy of the opinion of the Attorney General recently given to Representative Burmeister of La Salle County, in which the attorney general states that he called at your office, and was informed that "if the Commissioners Courts of Webb and La Salle counties would agree on the Mills Line, have it re-surveyed and remarked, etc., * * * the same would meet the requirements of that department."

I am in receipt of your favor of the 8th inst., in which you say to you are sending to Mr. Tom. Dooley, a copy of the Mills Line, sketch etc., to be used by him in re-surveying the line between Webb and La Salle count ties. I do not know Mr. Dooley, and think you are probably mistaken in to the name. I believe you must mean, Mr. Tom Atlee, who is the county surveyor of La Salle County. He will probably represent La Salle County when the survey is made, but Webb County must also have a representative on the ground, and as our commissioners wish to see this old Mills Line before they take final action in the matter, I am very anxious to secure a copy of the line. If you notice my last letter to you, you will see that I requested a copy of this line, and am perfectly willing to pay for it. If w you will let me know what it will cost, I will remit in advance. If you & can not tell the cost, send it & C .O.D., or send me a draft, and I will protect it on presentation. Your prompt attention to this matter is earnestly requested. I have your favor of the 19th inst, and with reference to the Mills line etc.

I wish to know if your departament is so cocksure that this line is the proper line. Why has it not been put so on your maps of webb and LaSalle Counties, which the Land Office puts out?

Furthermore where does it corner, the N. East corner of Webb would naturally be the S. East corner of LaSalle, and according to the Mills line, it may be some two miles south of where you

Another thing, we have on record here the survey of the eastern boundary of Encinal County, surveyed Sept,17,1877,by Lafayette Caldwell, Nueces L.D. Surveyor, S. M. Jarvis, Webb Co., Surveyor, and J. J. Dix, surveyor of Duval County. Their Field Notes describe the present north east corner of Webb, which is on the ground and would be according to the Mills survey two miles north of the south east corner of Lasalle County.

The Mills Field Notes have never been on record here, and in your copy of them it does not show where the surveyor of webb or any other adjoining County were present at this survey.
