## WEBB-DIMMIT BOUNDARY LINE

To the Honorable County Court of Webb County and the Honorable County Court of Dimmit County: 502

WHEREAS, the Honorable County Court of Webb County, Texas, did on the 14th. day of April, 1943 make and enter an order requiring a resurvey of the boundary line between Webb County and Dimmit County, and E. J. Foster, County Surveyor of Webb County was appointed to make said survey for and on behalf of Webb County, and said order fixed the date for the beginning of said survey on the 20th. day of May, 1943, and a copy of said order was duly served upon the Judge of the County Court of Dimmit County, on which latter date, I, E. J. Foster, County Surveyor of Webb County, having previously qualified according to law to perform said work, proceeded to the SE corner of Dimmit County in the W. boundary line of La Salle County, same being also the NE corner of Webb County, the beginning corner fixed by the order of the County Court, and there met J. F. Jones, the County Surveyor of Dimmit County and we jointly began the actual survey of the boundary line between our respective counties, the report of the joint survey being as follows:

It appearing to the satisfaction of the County Court of Webb County, Texas, that there exists uncertainty as to the location of the boundary line between Webb and Dimmit Counties, in that the line is not sufficiently definite and well defined and marked upon the ground, causing great confusion in determining the location of surveys alleged to border on, or to be cut by said boundary line, as to whether such surveys, or parts of said surveys are in one county or the other for the purpose of the assessment and collection of taxes thereon, and such confusion should be eliminated and said county line better defined and marked upon the ground; and the Commissioners' Court of Webb County having requested this County Court to act herein as is provided by law with reference to the boundaries of counties; therefore, I, M.
