

August Term A.D.1903.

Be it remembered that on this the 3 day of August A.D.1903, came to be holden a regular term of the County Court of Wheeler County, Texas.

Hon. J.M. Grigsby, CO. Judge, presiding.

Court opened at 10 o'clock A.M.

Whereupon the following proceedings were had to-wit:-

Coming to the knowledge of the County Court of Wheeler County, that the West boundary line of said County has not been properly located, it is ordered by said Court that Mark Huselby be employed by Wheeler County to help to locate said line, commencing at the North West corner of Wheeler County; thence running South to the South West corner of said County. Stone monuments properly marked to be placed at initial corners of said County, and galvanized iron pipe properly marked, driven in ground at end of every mile on boundary line of said County.

It is further ordered by the Court that said survey shall commence on the 10 day of August A.D.1903, and continue until completed.
