



1 Report of a survey of the county line between  
2 Wilbarger and Ford Counties made by order  
3 of the Commissioners Court of Wilbarger County  
4 at its Special term July 7<sup>th</sup> 1893.

5 Beginning at the established N. W. corner of  
6 Baylor County a large sand stone rock  
7 3 feet x 3 feet facing North and South and  
8 situated in the valley of South Beaver Creek  
9 marked  $N \frac{E}{K} : N. W \frac{B}{B}$  on the South side and H: W  
10 on the North side a large hackberry tree  
11 brs. N.  $25 \frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  E 128 vs. and another brs. N.  $21 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$   
12 E. 131 vs. and a round loon mound brs. S.  
13  $57 \frac{2}{3}^{\circ}$  W. 212 vs. All of the above bearings are  
14 found at the course and distance called for  
15 but the trees are not marked. Thence North  
16 at 375 vs. the South bank of Beaver Creek  
17 at 1281 vs. cross the South line of Sec. 64  
18 Block 18 H & T. C. R. R. Co. 583 vs. from its  
19 S. E. corner at  $1900 \frac{8}{10}$  vs. a sand stone  
20 marked I W on the E. side and F on the west  
21 side.

1. 22 Thence North at 1367 vs. cross S. line of No. 59  
23 Blk. 18, 2 vs from its S. E. corner at  $1900 \frac{8}{10}$  vs.  
24 a red <sup>sand</sup> stone marked 2 W on the E. side and  
25 F on the west.

2. 26 Thence North at 1453 vs. cross the South line  
27 of Sec. 55, 579 vs. from its S. W. corner at  
28  $1900 \frac{8}{100}$  vs. a red sand stone marked 3 W.  
29 on the E. and F. on west.

3. 30 Thence North at 1539 vs. cross the South line  
31 of sec. 54 Blk. 18, 740 vs. from its S. E.  
32 corner at  $1900 \frac{8}{10}$  vs. a red sand stone marked





1. 4<sup>th</sup> on the E. side and F on the west side.
4. 2. Thence North at 1625 vs. cross the S. line of  
3. sec. 49 Blk. 18, 159 vs from its S. E. corner at  
4. 1900  $\frac{8}{10}$  vs. a red sand stone marked 5<sup>th</sup> on the  
5. E. side and F on the West.
5. 6. Thence North at 1711 vs. cross the South line  
6. of sec. 47 Blk 18, 421 vs. from its S. W. corner  
7. at 1900  $\frac{8}{10}$  vs. a red sand stone marked 6<sup>th</sup>.  
8. on the E. side and F on the west side.
6. 10. Thence North at 1797 vs. cross the North line  
11. of sec. 47 Blk 18, at 1003 vs. from its N. W.  
12. corner at 1900  $\frac{8}{10}$  vs. a red sand stone marked  
13. 7<sup>th</sup> on the E. side and F on the west side
7. 14. Thence North at 1883 vs. cross the south line  
15. of sec. 32 Blk. 18, 116 vs. from its S. E. corner  
16. at 1900  $\frac{8}{10}$  vs. a red sand stone marked  
17. 8<sup>th</sup> on the E. side and F on the west.
8. 18. Thence North at 1900  $\frac{8}{10}$  vs. a red sand stone  
19. marked 9<sup>th</sup> on the E. side and F on the west  
20. side.
9. 21. Thence North at 68 vs. cross the S. line of sec.  
22. 28 Blk. 18, 454 vs. from its S. W. corner at  
23. 1900  $\frac{8}{10}$  vs. a red sand stone marked 10<sup>th</sup>  
24. on E. side and F on the west side.
10. 25. Thence North at 154 vs. cross the North line  
26. 28 Block 18, 1035 vs. from its N. W. corner  
27. at 1900  $\frac{8}{10}$  vs. a red sand stone marked 11  
28. <sup>th</sup> on the E. side and F on the west side.
11. 29. Thence North 1604 vs. cross the S. line of sec.  
30. 17 Block 8. 135 vs. from the S. W. corner at  
31. 1900  $\frac{8}{10}$  vs. a red sand stone marked 12<sup>th</sup>.  
32. on E side and F on the west.





- 12-1 Thence North at 1698 vs cross the S. line of  
2 sec. 16 Blk. 8 H + T. C. R. R. Co. 741 vs. from its  
3 S. W. corner at 1900  $\frac{8}{10}$  vs. a red sand stone  
4 marked 13 N. on the E. side and and F on the  
5 west side.
- 13-6 Thence North at 1792 vs. cross S. line of sec.  
7 15 Blk. 8, 1347 vs. from S. W. corner at 1900  $\frac{8}{10}$   
8 vs. a red sand stone marked 14 N. on the  
9 E. side and F on the west side.
- 14-10 Thence North at 1886 vs. cross the south  
11 line of No. 11 Blk. 8, 53 vs. from its S. W. corner  
12 at 1900  $\frac{8}{10}$  vs. a red sand stone marked 15-  
13 N. on the E. side and F on the west side.
- 15-14 Thence North at 1900  $\frac{8}{10}$  vs a red sand ---  
15 marked 16 N. on the E. side and F. on the  
16 west side.
- 16-17 Thence North at 80 vs. cross the North line  
18 of sec. 11 Blk. 8 659 vs. from its N. W. corner  
19 at 1900  $\frac{8}{10}$  vs. a red sand stone 3 feet high  
20 marked 17 N. on the E. side and F on the  
21 west side; This stone is on the East side  
22 of a sandy high bluff, on the south bank  
23 of Pease River from which a Chittum brs.  
24 S.  $49\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  E. 25 vs. and 2 Chittum 5" diam. brs  
25 N.  $54\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. 12  $\frac{1}{2}$  vs. from the two Chittum  
26 trees, the end of a red ridge brs. N.  $73\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$   
27 W.
- 17-28 Thence North at 40 vs. the south bank of  
29 the river on a high bluff at 1131 vs. a  
30 point in the middle of Pease river the  
31 N. E. corner of Ford County in the west  
32 line of Wilbarger County, from which a

1 cotton wood marked x on the north side  
2 brs. N 54° 38' 360 W. and a forked cotton  
3 wood both prongs marked on the north  
4 brs. N. 31° 58' W. 408 W.

5 Survey made Aug. 31<sup>st</sup> and Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> 1893  
6 run made on true Meridian, the average  
7 magnetic va. 10° 10' E.
