

The State of Texas } Agreeable to an order of the  
County of Wood } County Court of said County  
held in the Court house in the Town of Quitman  
at the regular term of said Court on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday  
in May A.D. 1852. Which said Court did show and there  
appeared J. C. Simmons to run that portion of the County  
Line between the N. W. corner of Upshur and the S. E. corner  
of Hopkins and by failure of the said Simmons J  
A. Bradshaw proceeded on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June to run said  
line it being marked previously.

Beginning at the S. E. corner of Hopkins. Thence East  
2500 varas to a Road leading from Russell to L. Thomas  
Thence East 4360 varas to the Dry Fork, Cypress Course  
N. of E. at a Black Gum marked T. C. also a Black Oak  
marked T. C. Which said stream with its meanders is the  
natural boundary between the S. W. corner of Titus and  
the N. E. corner of Wood For the connecting line we pro-  
ceeded to the N. W. corner of a Survey known as the  
Black Stock Head right N. W. of 100 Acres  
Thence East 870 varas to the Upshur and Wood  
County Line Thence North 1500 varas to the  
N. W. corner of Upshur and N. E. corner of Wood  
The above corner upon a Red Oak which is now  
dead 5 inches in di. White Oak marked - X  
another White Oak marked - X with other marks  
rather defaced
