Enclosed herewith I send copy of Field notes of Wood and Hopkins county line, which was established on D. O. Norton line. The disputed line between Wood and Franklin has been amicably adjusted. The surveyors began at the east end of Gilbert and Craddock line, and continued east to Dry Fork a Cypress, and thence down said Fork to Camp County. They found the D. O. Norton line to be common with this line, as far as Norton line run. I will send copy of Parker + Cowan field notes, as soon as approved by our Comis Court

The State of Texas } To the Hon. Commissioners,
Wood County } Court of Wood County, Texas.
November Term A.D. 1880.

In accordance with an order of said Court passed on the 7th day of October A.D. 1880. appointing the undersigned to assist in running and establishing the boundary line between Wood and Hopkins Counties to be begun on the eleventh day of October, 1880. at the Southeast corner of Hopkins County I, on said 11th day of October 1880. met James L. Gilbert, the surveyor appointed by the Commissioners^{Court} of said Hopkins County to ascertain the said boundary line and to make and establish the said line and corners thereof in the manner prescribed by law, at the place appointed, and we then and there began the survey of said line, making the following notes thereof, to-wit:

1st mile

Beginning at a stake set by the Franklin County Surveyors, in 1878 for the Southeast corner of Hopkins County; thence west 100 varas to a black jack marked S.C. on west side of an old road, at 770 varas a branch 100 wide course S. W., a sweep gum 20 in dia marked S.C. bro north, at 1000 varas a branch 100 wide course S. W. an Elm on east bank marked N.C. bro. East; thence passing through the farm of J. M. Kay Sr. at 1900 varas set stone in a small branch from which a double water Oak 6 in dia marked S.C. bro due west 9 1/2 varas

2nd mile

Thence west at 500 varas a branch 100 wide
course S. N. at 1210 varas Big Sandy Creek 300
wide course S. a Pin oak 18 in dia marked H. C.
bro north. at 1900 7/10 varas. set stone for 2nd mile.
from which a Black Oak 24 in dia mkd H. C. &
H. C. bro. S. 73 E 900. and a black oak stump
20 in dia bro S. 10 N. 3 7/10 00. the oak marked
being on the road leading from J. Alvis to
Winsboro.

3rd mile

Thence West 690 varas road leading from
old County line church to Wesley Jones place.
a Red Oak 24 in dia marked H. C. bro East
road runs S. N. at 1640 varas the Winsboro
and Black Jack Grove road from which
a Hickory 14 in dia mkd H. C. bro north-
easterly 10 00 - and a Post Oak 20 in dia mor
ked H. C. bro southeast 15 00. at 1900 7/10 00 set
stone from which a Black Oak 18 in dia bro
S. 45 N. 100. mkd 28 and 3

4th mile

Thence West at 500 varas a branch 100 wide
course South. at 550 00 - East boundary of the John
Shaw survey 900 00. north from the S. E. corner
of same - at 1900 7/10 00 on northern mound
for 4th mile from which a black jack 10
in dia marked H. C. bro N. 63. E. 700. and
a black oak 8 in dia bro. S. 20. W. 4 00.
mkd H. C.

5th mile

Thence West at 1900 7/10 00 set stone
from which a black oak 10 in dia
marked H. C. bro. N 5 00. Hickory 10 in
dia mkd H. C. bro S. 18 E. 5 00.

6th mile

Thence west at 115 00 a road a black jack

marked H. C. on north side and H. C. on south
side. at 7850 vs a branch 100 wide course n.
50 W. at 12200 vs. a branch 100 wide course n. 15
W. at 19000 vs. set stone for 6th mile. from
which a black jack 10 in dia marked W. C.
brs. S. 2 vs - and a post oak 20 in dia marked
H. C. brs n. 65 E. 12 vs.

7th mile

Thence west 180 vs small road from which
a Post Oak 14 in dia brs South 45 W. 3 vs marked
W. H. C. at 12500 vs. a branch 100 wide course
S. E. at 18600 vs a branch 3 vs wide course north
at 19000 vs threw up an earth mound
for seventh mile. from which a Post Oak
21 in dia marked H. C. 7 - brs due East 8
vs.

8th mile

Thence west at 11000 vs the most
easterly Tutmon and Sulphur Springs road
via Black Oak Church. from which a P. O.
12 in dia brs n. E. 12 vs marked H. C. and
a Post. O. 14 in dia brs S. E. 10 vs - marked
H. C. at 15000 vs creek 3 vs wide course north
at 19000 vs a Post Oak 70 in dia marked
H. C. on north side and H. C. on south
side. a willow oak 14 in dia brs north
5 vs - a Post Oak 18 in dia marked 8 brs
south 6. vs.

9th mile

Thence west at 5600 vs Cony Creek course
W. S. W. at 9200 vs branch 100 wide course
S. E. at 19000 vs - set stone from which a
Post Oak 12 in dia marked H. C. brs north
2 vs - a Post. Oak 10 in dia marked H. C.
brs S. W. 2 vs -

10th mile

Thence west at 12000 vrs branch, vt wide course S. at 6600 vrs. a branch, vt. wide course south at 1900 & 1000 vrs built on earthen mound for 10th mile from which a P. O. 16 in dia marked N. 10. brs due south, 12 vrs. and a Post oak marked W. 12 in dia brs S. 32 W. 10 vrs.

11th mile

Thence west at 10000 vrs N. S. of a survey near east bank of Coffee Creek. at 10300 vrs Coffee Creek 6 vrs wide course S. at 1900 & 1000 vrs built on earthen mound from which a P. O. 20 in dia marked N. 10 - 11 brs north 1 vrs. a P. O. 30 in dia marked N. brs N. 57 E. 28 vrs.

12th mile

Thence west at 18600 vrs to Sulphur Springs. Riley Springs and Quitman road. a P. O. 10 in dia marked N. 10. brs north east a Post oak marked W. brs South east. at 1900 & 1000 vrs built mound for 12th mile. from which a Red oak 8 in dia marked X. in running this mile the west boundary line of Nacogdoches University Land was crossed at a point 8850 vrs. north of the south west corner of same.

13th mile

Thence west at 20000 vrs Running Creek 6 vrs. wide course S. a bending sweet gum on west side 2 feet dia marked N. on east side + W. on west side at 7200 vrs branch 1 vt. wide course south. at 15000 vrs. a road a Post O. 14 in dia on west side marked W. another 12 in dia on west side marked N. at 1900 & 1000 vrs. a Post oak 12 in dia marked 13 on east side

and 18 on west side. From which a P. O. 20 in
mkd L. L. brs due east 9 vrs.

14th mile

Thence west 1880 vrs. Glade Creek 1 vrs.
wide course south. at 1900 9/10 vrs set ~~stone~~
from which a sweet gum 8 in dia mkd
L. L. brs East 6 vrs. a willow oak 18 in dia mkd
W. C. brs S. 25 to 11 5/10 vrs.

15th mile

Thence west at 20 vrs. a road. at 1900 9/10
vrs. built an earthen mound for 15th mile.
from which a Hickory, 12 in dia brs due
south 5 vrs. - marked N. and a Hickory 8
in dia mkd N. brs N. 15 to 5 vrs.

16th mile

Thence west at 275 vrs a branch, 1 vt
wide course East. at 1130 vrs the Quitman
and Black Jack Grove road. a Hickory
10 in dia mkd N. brs S. E., and a Hick 12
in dia mkd N. brs N. W., at 1900 9/10 vrs
built an earthen mound from which a
P. O. 14 in dia mkd N. brs South 3 vrs. and
another 14 in dia mkd N. brs. northeast 4 vrs

17th mile

Thence west at 970 vrs branch 1 vt.
wide course south a P. O. 14 in dia mkd
N. C. (on each bank) another 12 in dia on
some bank mkd N. C., at 1900 9/10 vrs a P. O. 8
in dia mkd N. on south side and 14. on
north side. a P. O. 14 in dia brs. N. C. 1 1/2 vrs
a P. O. 6 in dia brs N. W. 1 vrs. both marked
N

18th mile

Thence west at 700 vrs. a branch 1
vt. wide course W. S. N. at 1040 vrs a branch
3 vrs wide course north. at 1900 9/10 vrs an
ash 10 in dia marked N. C. - on north line
