Replying further to your letter of October 19, 1918, in regard to application for a Patent on the J.H. White Pre-Emption on the line of Erath and Hamilton Counties, I enclose you herewith map which is furnished me by Capt. W.T. Saxon who has been County Surveyor in this county since 1858. Capt. Saxon is getting quite old but his map I think correctly locates all of the surveys in this end of the county, showing you the White Pre-emption. He locates it by actual survey on the West of the Wm. Smith, East of the Kelly, North of the Preston and South of the Stauffer. In conversation with me he tells me that sometime in the early 90's he, together with J.M. Robinson, the County Surveyor of Bosque County, went over these surveys, locating the bearings and this land was unaccounted for and untaken and J.H. White was living on it and then white filed his application and has since dealt with it as his own. In fact, has sold it and several parties are now owners and they are undertaking to straighten up their titles.

I trust with this plat and this explanation that you can issue the patent.
