Receipt is acknowledged of your letter of January 27, 1966 in which you enclosed a copy of the Final Judgement in the captioned matter and the original boundary line plat prepared by surveyors John R. Wilson and John N. Wilson, and being officially approved by the Honorable R. W. Caton, Dist. Judge, 118th Judicial Dist. of Texas.

Pursuant to your request we have examined and filed these instruments in the land office records. The county line boundary and the respective maps are being corrected accordingly and all of the pertinent abstracts for the surveys effected by this boundary line are being duly corrected, also the County Assessors-Collectors will be officially notified of this action.

There is one exception in the afore mentioned corrections and that is for Garza County Abstract 1166, J. J. Koonsman, Sec. 1, SF-7526. This survey very obviously contains considerable excess; however, there are no corrected field notes of record in this office on which the abstracts can be corrected. The survey is patented for 23.75 acres and yet this new county line map shows 27.5 acres in Garza County alone.

ORDER OF COURT APPROVING REPORT OF SURVEYORS AND WAIVING OF PENALTY AND INTEREST ON AD VALOREM TAX PAYMENTS

ON THIS the 20th day of December, A.D. 1965, came on to be heard in the above entitled and numbered case the Report of the Surveyors appointed by this Court to survey and establish on the ground the boundary line between Borden County, Texas and Garza County, Texas, made in obedience to the order of this Court which was made on the 31st day of August, A.D. 1965, and it appearing to the Court, after having examined the same carefully and no exceptions or objections having been made thereto, and having heard evidence in favor of and against the same, that said survey has been actually made by said surveyors on the ground in accordance with law and in accordance with the judgment and order of this Court made on the 31st day of August, 1965;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that said Report of Survey, together with the Field Notes and Plat of Survey accompanying same, be, and it is hereby, in all respects approved and ordered entered of record by the Clerk of this Court; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the true boundary line between Borden County, Texas and Garza County, Texas, be, and it is hereby, decreed and established to be located as shown by said Report and the accompanying Field Notes and Plat of said survey; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that said surveyors be allowed a fee of \$5,845.50 for their services, to be taxed as costs herein, and it further appearing that all costs herein have been paid, no order is entered in connection therewith.

The Court further finds that MALCOLM WALKER, GENERAL AMERICAN OIL COMPANY, ALVIN KOONSMAN and CORA GUILLIAMS have paid ad valorem taxes on property located along the boundary of Borden and Garza Counties into the registry of the District Clerk's office of Howard County, Texas pending final settlement of this dispute and that

said ad valorem taxes were not timely paid to Borden County, Garza County and the State of Texas. That penalties and interest have accrued on said failure to timely pay said ad valorem taxes to said taxing agencies but that, under the circumstances, the collection of penalties and interest would be unfair to said taxpayers. It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that Borden County, Garza County and the State of Texas be and they are hereby ordered not to collect any penalties or interest from MALCOLM WALKER, GENERAL AMERICAN OIL COMPANY, ALVIN KOONSMAN and CORA GUILLIAMS on those taxes paid into the Registry of the District Clerk as hereinabove set out but the same are hereby in all things ordered waived.

The Court having heretofore entered an order approving report of survyeors dated November 22, 1965 and the Court still having jurisdiction of this matter and being of the opinion that said judgment should be withdrawn and corrected and this judgment substituted therefore, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the judgment of November 22, 1965 is withdrawn and this judgment substituted therefor.
