

DESCRIPTION OF TDC 1985 SALES TRACT 4 _____

47.976 Acres in the A. Hodge League A-32 in Fort Bend County, Texas and being a portion of land out of the Texas Department of Corrections land as described in the Reclamation Department Bulletin No. 26; the said 47.976 Acres being more particularly located and described as follows:

Beginning at a concrete monument found for the "fifth corner" described on Page 8 of the Field Notes in the Reclamation Department Bulletin No. 26 and also being the southwest corner of that certain 8.4302 acre tract described in Warranty Deed from the Texas Board of Corrections to John Donald Hull, et ux dated November 12, 1984, recorded in volume 1567 on pages 688-694 of the Deed Records of Fort Bend County, Texas;

THENCE with the south line of said 8.4302 acre tract North 87° 17' 45" East 369.83 feet to a concrete monument found for the southeast corner of said 8.4302 acre tract on the west Right-of-Way line of Texas State Highway No. 6 for the northeast corner of this tract;

THENCE with said Right—of—Way line along a curve to the right the radius of which is 5629.58 feet an arc distance of 508.43 feet — the long chord bears South 4° 49' 35" East 508.26 feet — to a concrete monument found at the end of said curve;

THENCE with said Right—of—Way South 11° 24' 53" East 61.11 feet to a 5/8 inch Iron Rod found;

THENCE with said Right—of—Way South 2° 15′ 37″ East, at 1603.33 feet pass a one inch galvanized iron pipe set for reference, in all 1703.33 faat; THENCE with said Right-of-Way South 3° 27' 00" West 100.50 feet;

THENCE with said Right-of-Way South 2° 15' 37" East 80.00 feet to the southeast corner of this tract in lake;

THENCE along the approximate centerline of said lake the following 5 courses: (1) North 49° 32' 00" West 580.00 feet; (2) North 39° 15' 56" West 1064.67 feet to a one inch galvanized iron pipe set in the centerline of abandoned railroad tracks; (2) North 20 pipe set in the centerline of abandoned railroad tracks;

(3) North 15° 00' 00" West 436.59 feet; (4) North 6° 12' 00" West 390.00 feet; (5) North 24° 50' 00" East 434.00 feet to the northwest corner of this tract;

THENCE North 87° 24' 20" East at 300.00 feet pass a one inch galvanized iron pipe set for reference, in all 600.00 feet to the place of beginning. Containing 47.967 Acres, more or less.

Bearings herein are grid based on the Texas Coordinate System, South Central Zone. Distances are horizontal surface measurements. The above description was prepared from a survey made on the ground under my supervision during the months of June and July, 1985 and is depicted on Plat of Survey dated July 25, 1985 accompanying this, which reference is made hereto and a part hereof. From the beginning corner, Tri-Station STATE bears South 6° 42' 44'' West 20,921.62 feet. Published coordinates of STATE: X = 3,061,275.78 Y = 645,599.39
