No 1, 2, 3 & 4 to gather with a
copy of a survey made by me

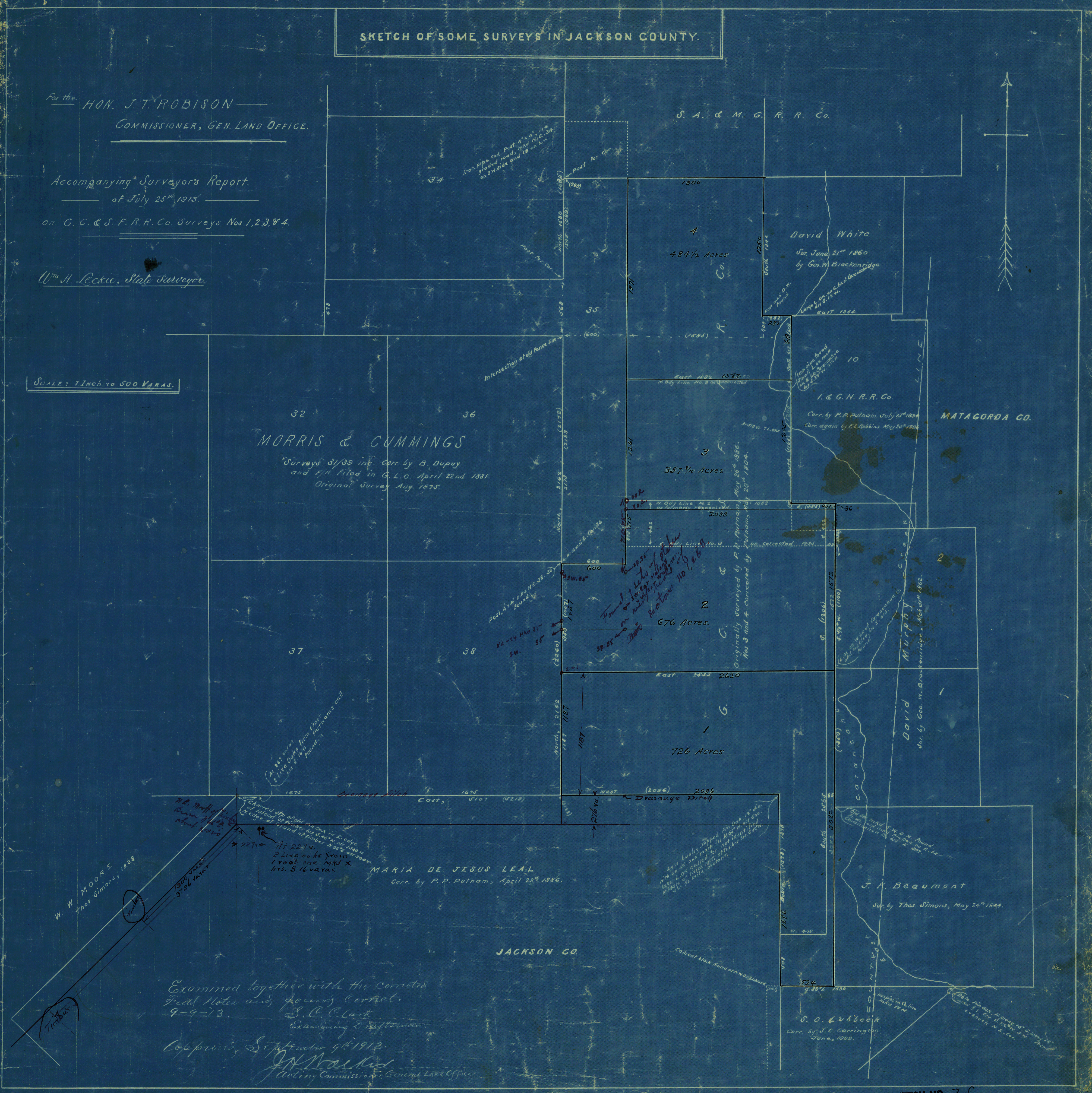
