N. E. Corner of King and the N. W. Corner  
of Knox County as established by W. A. Millington  
in October 1899: a mesquite post 6 ft  
long 8 in square marked 70ard on the  
North side. King on S. W. side and  
Knox on S. E. side in mound 2½ feet  
deep also a gyp. Rock 2½ ft long marked  
Oct<sup>r</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> 1899 on South side of Post and  
a large two year old Buffalo Horn  
buried in mound said mound and  
Corner is on the South side of middle  
 Wichita River in horse Shoe Bend of  
same. and a bunch of hackberries one  
marked K on west side and K on E. side


