E. corner of said Santa Petronila grant, the S. W. corner of said San Antonio del Alamo grant, at 1900.8 varas set a cedar post marked VII on the West, K on the South, and N on the North. Thence East at 807 varas enter a pond, at 912 varas leave same, at 1900.8 varas set a cedar post marked VIII on the

West, K of the South, and N on the North. Thence East 1003 varas Noria Honda bears S.2°54'W. at 1900.8 varas set a concrete pillar marked 9 on the West, K on the South, and N on the North. Thence East at 576 varas enter Laguna del Huisache, at 1440 varas leave same, at 1900.8 varas set a cedar post marked X on the West, K on the South, and N on the North. Thence East at 621.7 varas said Noria Honda bears S.46°51' W. at 1451.2 varas the N. E. corner of said Los Sauces grant in the name of Jose Antonio Hinojosa, a large Mezquite post marked ^{XXXII}_K intersecting the Western boundary line of El Chiltipin grant in the name of Blas Maria Falcon, at 1900.8 varas set a cedar post marked XI on the West, K on the South, and N on the North. Thence East at 1900.8 varas set a concrete pillar marked 12 on the West, K on the South, and N on the North. Thence East at 1900.8 varas set a cedar post marked XIII on the West, K on the South, and N on the North, whence the Chiltipin Windmill bears S.52°30'E. Thence East at 1900.8 varas set a cedar post marked XIV on the West, K on the South, and N on the North. Thence East at 528.6 varas said Chiltipin Windmill bears S.24°50'E. at 1900.8 varas set a concrete pillar marked 15 on the West, K on the South, and N on the North. Thence East at 534.5 varas said Chiltipin Windmill bears S.12°07'W. at 1900.8 varas set a cedar post marked XVI on the West, K on the South, and N on the North. Thence East at 456 varas cross a small Creek below a broken dam, at 1719.4 varas intersect a fence with telephone line running N.36°30'W. at 1751 varas cross road to old Muerto ranch running Northwesterly, at 1900.8 varas set a cedar post marked XIX on the West, K on the South, and N on the North. Thence East at 583.7 varas the Eastern gable of the large barn at the Laureles ranch bears S.24°39'E. and the Viruelas Windmill bears N.23°26'E. at 1812.7

varas said barn at the Laureles ranch bears S.3°46'W. and said Virhuelas Windmill bears N.6°21'W. at 1900.8 varas set a cedar post marked XX on the West, K on the South, and N on the North. Thence N.89°48'40"W. at 1451.8 varas enter a pond, at 1530.8 varas leave same, at 1674.55 varas Mezquite post marked E, about 2 feet high, the S. W. corner of Nancy Abbey Survey No. 351, Veteran Donation Certificate No. 1114, bears ~~xxxx~~ N.56°31'20"E. 165.64 varas, at 1900.8 varas pass a concrete pillar marked 58 on the West, N on the North, and B on the South. Thence N.89°48'40"W. at 291.52 varas the stone monument at the Southeastern corner of the Paisano grant bears S.7°01'20" W. 364.46 varas, at 1900.8 varas pass a cedar post marked 57 on the West, N on the North, and B on the South. Thence N.89°48'40"W. at 818.42 varas pass a cedar post marked N on the North, and B on the South, marking the location of the 4-League boundary post set by J. J. Thence N.89°48'40"W. at 1218.8 varas center of the Palo Blanco Creek running Southeasterly, at 1585.6 varas the place of beginning.
