survey the true boundary line between said  
Counties.

Commencing said Survey at the Common  
S.W. Cor. of Baylor County and the N.W. Cor. of  
Throckmorton Counties and run due West  
30 Miles Working each Mile as required by  
law in such cases more and provided.

The time set for beginning said Survey to  
be fixed for the third Monday in May 1888.

And it is further ordered that a copy of  
this order be furnished the County Commis-  
sioners Court of Haskell County with request  
that they appoint a Competent Surveyor to  
act in junction with the Surveyor of this coun-  
ty in ascertaining said Boundary line

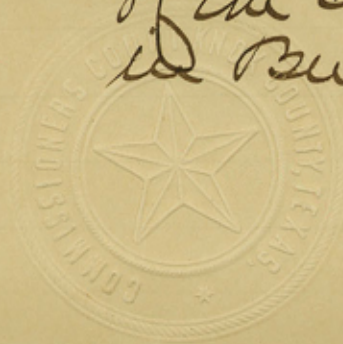
