

Gentlemen:

I am herewith submitting a survey plat with exhibits for your approval of the boundary line between State-owned Laguna Madre and the above referenced privately owned land. This site is about 3/4 of a mile north of a State owned tract, the boundary of which you approved by letter dated February 19, 1981 and filed as Nueces County Rolled Sketch No. 73.

There is a small bulkhead built along the shoreline and this bulkhead was used for the boundary instead of an elevation. Although there has been shoreline alteration in this area, an examination of the accompanying exhibits shows this particular site to be relatively unchanged. I find no evidence of any artificial fill or accretion on this site.

- 1. Aerial photo taken in 1934 by Tobin.
- 2. Aerial photo taken on 2-7-50.
- 3. Aerial photo with date unknown, but believed to be between 1965 and 1975.
- 4. Pita Island, Texas quadrangle (7.5 minute series) dated 1969 and photo revised in 1975.

Re: The line between submerged land and private ownership along Lots 5, 6 and 1, Blk. 5, Tyler Subdivision, Nueces County.

Gentlemen:

In response to a report dated June 2, 1982 with exhibits, signed by George Pyle, a Licensed State Land Surveyor, this office has reviewed the information and finds that the survey as made, based upon the bulkhead and evidence that it follows the original shoreline, is the correct line between the submerged lands belonging to the Permanent School Fund and uplands privately owned.

The plat, report and supporting evidence have been filed as Nueces County Rolled Sketch No. 78.
