

Dear Herman:

I am herewith submitting a survey for General Land Office approval of the shoreline boundary between the riparian owners and State owned Cayo Del Oso Tract "D".

This survey lies East of and adjacent to a 1.337 acre tract out of Lot 21, Section 40, Flour Bluff and Encinal Farm & Garden Tracts, Nueces County for which you approved the shoreline boundary by letter dated August 29, 1983 and filed as Nueces County Rolled Sketch No. 90.

The shoreline on this Survey was established at elevation 1.5 feet, N.G.V.D. the same as all previous surveys in this area(See Nueces County Rolled Sketch No. 63 and Nueces County Rolled Sketch No. 77 to 77D).

The shoreline of this survey is natural with no artificial fill.

I am also enclosing Glasson-Lammon Aerial Photo 9882-11, dated October 14, 1982.
