SURVEY REPORT

July 29, 1992

Blocks 1 and 2, Section 18, Padre Island-Corpus Christi, Nueces County, Texas.

The subject tract is owned by Ane B. Westerberg and adjoins State Submerged Tract No. 61 in Laguna Madre.

This property was surveyed by Urban Engineering and monitored by Ray Wisdom, former Survey Director of the G.L.O., in 1968. The shoreline was determined as elevation of 0.68 feet (1927 M.S.L. Datum) and is shown on an Urban Engineering plat dated May 6, 1968, under job no. 1921-B, a copy of which you have in your files. It is my understanding that the G.L.O. approved the shoreline shown on the 1968 plat from Padre Island Drive South to the county line. but not on the subject tract which is labeled 69.62 acres on the Urban plat.

The shoreline shown on the accompanying survey was set in accordance with the current M.H.H.W. elevation of 2.96 feet on the Blucher Institute Packery Channel, Laguna Madre, Texas Tide Gage (Station No. 877-5792).

This tide gage reading of 2.96 feet translates to an elevation of 1.21 feet based on the datum that Urban Engineering used in 1968.

On the current survey I have followed the existing shoreline except for a small portion at the Southwest corner which was dredged out by the Navy and ownership should remain with the upland owner even though now below M.H.H.W. For this portion of the boundary I extended a line from a point at elevation 2.96 feet, just North of the dredged portion in a Southwesterly direction, parallel to the shoreline shown by the county engineer on exhibit no. 3. The deed to the county (Vol. 474, Page 276, D.R.N.C.T.) calls for "Mean High Tide Elevation" on this shoreline but does not specify elevation used.

There are two or three long narrow depressions in the Northeast portion of this survey which sometimes hold water and at other times are dry, depending on whether rain or very high tides have filled them up. At the present time all these depressions are dry except for the one furthest North which can be seen on exhibit no. 8. This depression at the present time is connected to Packery Channel by a narrow $(4 \pm \text{feet})$ ditch with its bottom elevation at Packery Channel being about 3 inches below M/H.H.W. On exhibits 4 and 5, there is no well defined connection to Packery Channel but there is some slight indication of a connection. On exhibits 6 and 7 there is no connection at all between the depression and Packery Channel.

Prior to 1991, Packery Channel was redredged and the spoil was disposed of in the diked area which can be seen on exhibit no. 8. A drainage pipe through this dike is located near the Southwest end of the depression which is affected by the tide and I believe the well defined ditch to Packery Channel on exhibit no. 8 was either dug or eroded by the dredge water flowing from the diked area.

In my opinion, this depression is not naturally connected to Packery Channel except at tide levels well above M.H.H.W. and I have included it within the upland boundary.

NOTE: I made a survey of this same tract on July 9, 1985 and on my plat I have the following note: "Shoreline boundary approved by General Land Office by letter dated December 18, 1970 signed by Jerry Sadler, Commissioner."

I can not locate this letter in my files but it must be in the G.L.O. office.
