A Joint Resolution for the relief of O de A Santangelo. Section
First, Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Republic of Texas in congress assembled, That O de A Santangelo had
the thanks of congress for the firm and zealous support with which
he had maintained the cause of Texian Independence in the periodical
entitled "El Correro Atlantico" in opposition to the oppression of
the enemies [sic] of civil and religious liberty, Section Second Be
it further resolved that the Board of Land commissioners for the
county of Harrisburg be and are hereby required to issue to O de A
Santangelo a certificate for one league and labor of land, which grant
is hereby made to O de A Santangelo as a Donation by the Republic of
Texas
