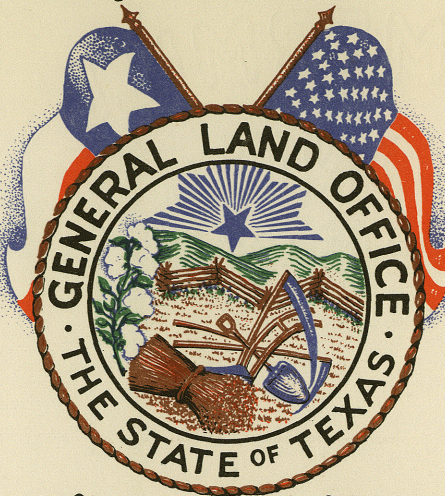

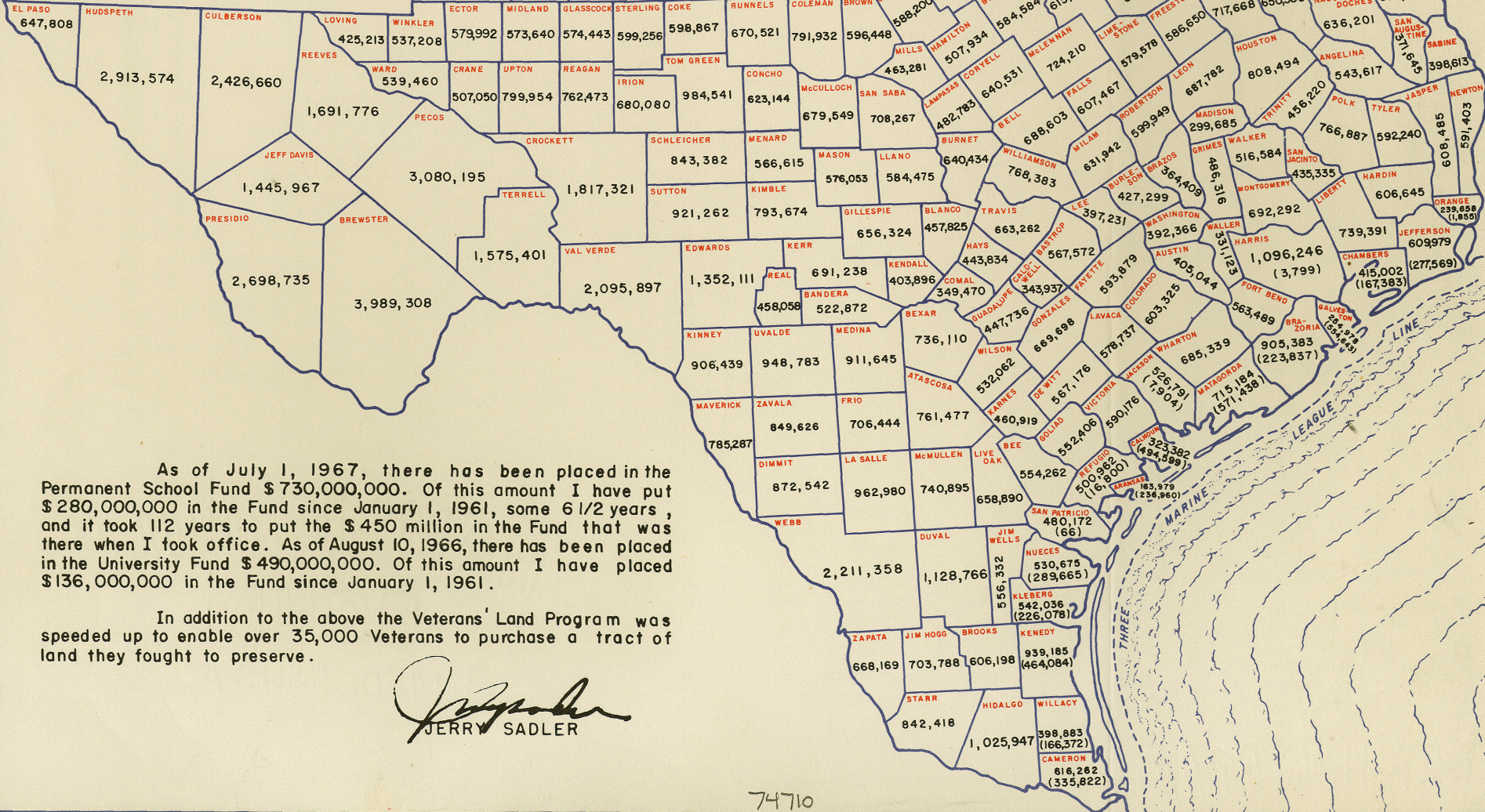

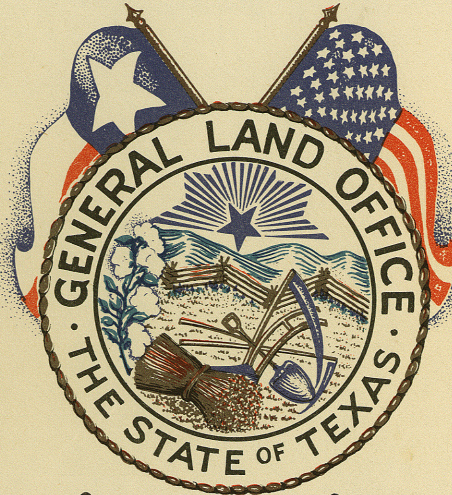

In addition to the above the Veterans' Land Program was speeded up to enable over 35,000 Veterans to purchase a tract of land they fought to preserve.

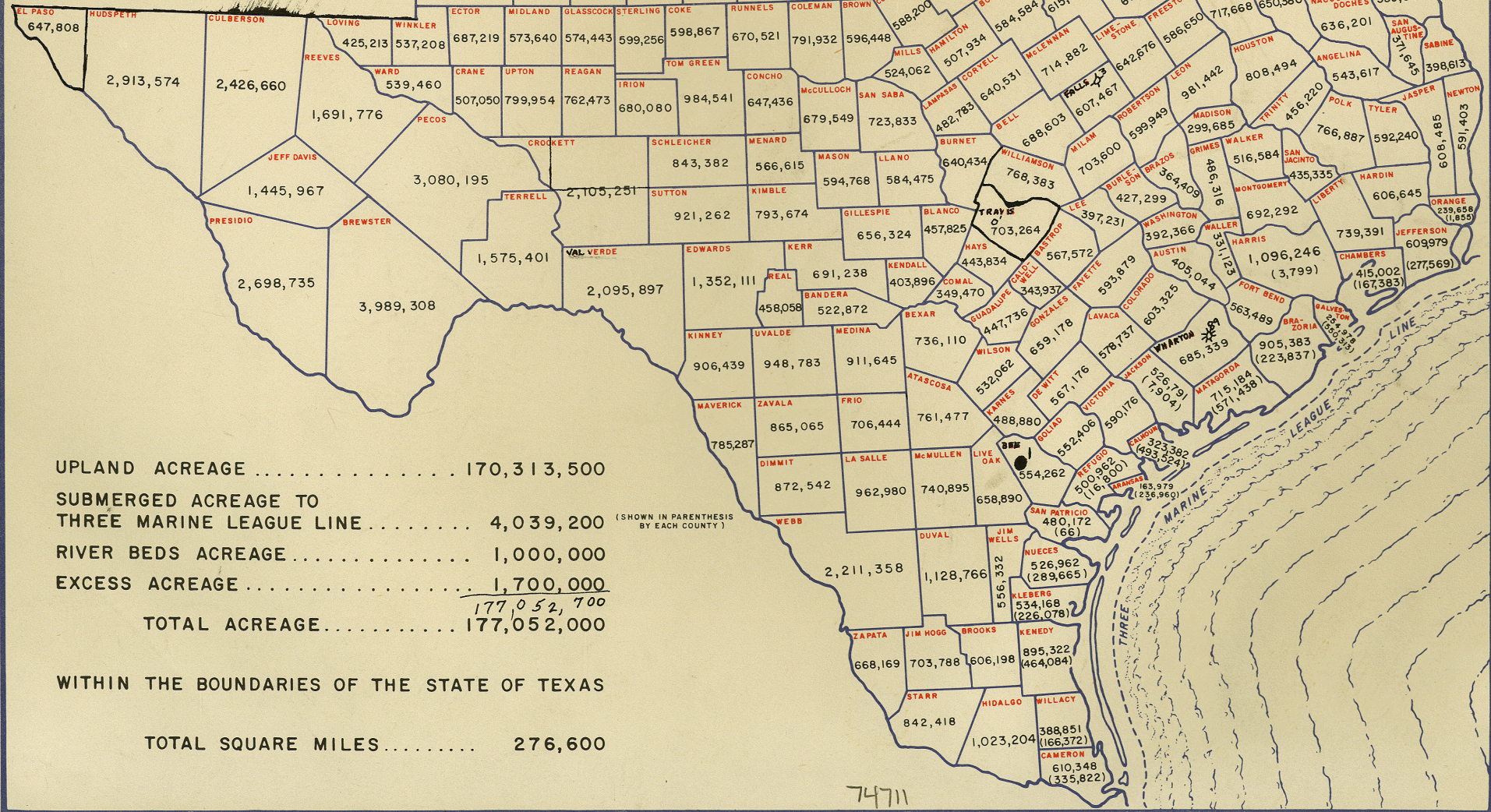
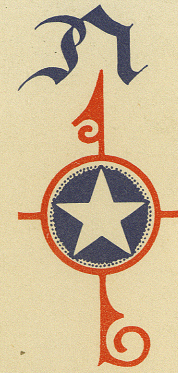

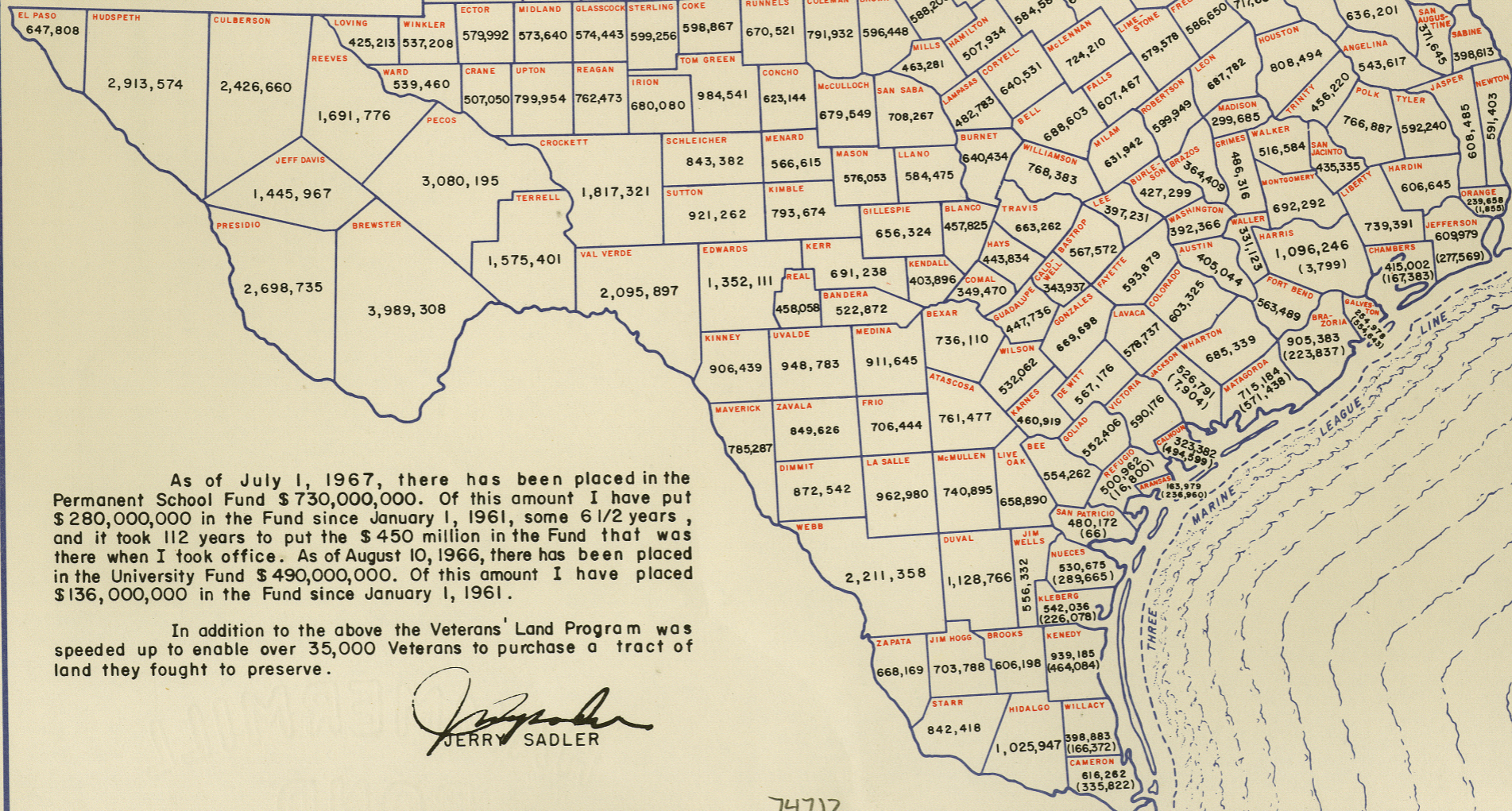
