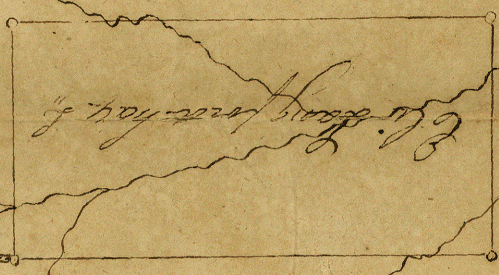

18 deg West 3 Varas from a Pine tree
Thence No 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ deg West 5000 Varas with
Vincent Andersons Line to Pica Andersons
South East Corner at a Stake No 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ deg
West 10 Varas from a Poplar tree & No
5 $\frac{1}{2}$ deg East 4 Varas from a Water oak
tree passing through Pines & oak Timber
crossing at branch at 400 Varas & Crossing
a branch at 4400 Varas
Thence No 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ deg East 2500 Varas to a
Stake No 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ deg West 9 Varas from a
Whit oak tree & No 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ deg East 1 Vara
from a Pine tree crossing Dutchy Creek
at 1950 Varas Timber Pine Whit oak
Red oak Gum &c
Thence No 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ deg East 5000 Varas to a
Stake No 65 deg West 3 Varas from a
Whit oak tree standing on the bank of
a small branch & No 50 deg East 5
Varas from a Sweet gum tree passing
through timbered Land as before cross-
ing Dutchy Creek at 4000 Varas
Thence No 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ deg West 2500 Varas to
the beginning crossing Wolf Creek at 2000
Varas passing through timber as before
