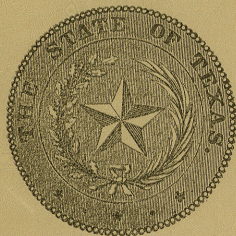


The Law requires all payments for University, School and Asylum Lands, and purchases made under various Acts to be made to the State Treasurer—they must not be sent to this office.

Dear Sir:

Whereas it appears that certain land near the S. B. line of Brasly co and N. B. line of Garza Co: has been patented through error of the facts, that is really the property of one Jno. W. Holmes as is represented and shown by patent No. 255 Vol 3. Ser. no. 2 in N. Aycock Block No. 1. and was duly transferred by sd Aycock to Jno W. Holmes as assee. on file in your office S. - 17302, and was patented to sd. Jno W. Holmes of date Dec. 15<sup>th</sup> 1882. The St Louis Battle Co's patent under which they presumably hold the same land was not issued until Feby 22/1883 and now hold <sup>new</sup> patent of date Nov: 15<sup>th</sup> 1887, J. W. E. Kaye in behalf and as agent of sd Jno. W. Holmes pray you to recall sd patent No. 526, vol: 10, issued Nov: 15<sup>th</sup> 1887, for cancellation.
