Please find enclosed with this report a plat showing a shoreline survey of Tract Two, Alta Vista Hotel Tract shown as the Lucy V. Welch Tract on a map of Alta Vista Heights recorded in Volume 19, Page 87 of the Map Records, Nueces County, Texas.

This tract adjoins Corpus Christi Bay State Tract #74 and the littoral owner, Mr. Theodore Dimopoulos is requesting General Land Office approval of the shoreline boundary for the purposes of platting the property according to the City of Corpus Christi requirements.

The north corner of this tract is under a great deal of fill which was placed on the original Alta Vista Hotel tract, however, the remainder of the shoreline, while having some concrete debris scattered on it, appears to be a fairly natural extension of the bluff. This debris extends to the original property line and then drops off to the natural sandy bay bottom. The seawall to the southeast of this tract extends parallel to and 1.0' beyond the property line.

I have also enclosed with this report a copy of the Alta Vista Heights Subdivision and a January 8, 2003 aerial photograph by Lanmon Aerial Photography, Inc., scanned and enlarged for clarity, not to scale.
