We enclose herewith a blue print of 'Surveys in Gregg County Texas'. This map for your office records.

We concientiously believe this map to be the most accurate, or at least one of the most accurate and complete maps in existence covering it's area. We have endeavored to re-establish some of the survey lines that have been shifted thru the years. The principle one among these that we would call,your attention to is the WBL of the L.B.Outlaw Survey #241, which is a common line with the Mary Scott Survey and John Blair Survey. We also wish to call your attention to the NWC of the Wilkerson Survey, which is one of the oldest corners in this vicinity. We find this corner to be as accurate as any corner could be in the absence of the original witness trees as we have checked it every way possible.

The WBL of the L.B.Outlaw Survey #243 is located call distance West from its place of beginning, a very definite corner, and is thus established and shown on our map for the reason that after a very careful search of the records, and on the ground, we can find nothing to substantiate placing it elsewhere.

If you have any criticism to offer, or any reason to think that any of the headright lines as shown hereon should be located differently, we would appreciate your comments. We have devoted much time and effort to making this map, hoping to construct in it one that would serve as a criterion in the section it covers.

You will note that two other Licensed State Surveyors have collaborated with us on this map. They have carefully checked it, much of the work on the ground, and agree with us on practically everything shown.

We trust that this map will prove of some benefit to you, and would appreciate a letter from you acknowledging its receipt.
