NOTE.—The above Table of Population is prepared from an official document which lately appeared, fixing the apportionment of Representatives, with the base of 1 to 70,000; the 7,000,000 Mexicans to elect 100 Deputies. Besides the 100, 60 others are chosen by officers of the administration and magistrates, and by the army and clergy. The foreign population is not included in the above enumeration. In addition to the above States, &c., there are two inferior Territories, called Colima and Tlascala.

*Recently established as a separate State or Department, being taken from Jalisco and the adjoining territory, the area included in Jalisco, &c.

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
