

SURVEYOR'S REPORT

On the Mean High Water Survey of Part of the South Bank Of Chigger Creek (AKA Chigoe Bayou) lying within the Sarah McKissick Survey, Abstract 151 Galveston County, Texas

The line of Mean High Water of part of the South Bank of Chigger Creek (AKA Chigoe Bayou) lying within the Sarah McKissisk Survey, Abstract 151, Galveston County, Texas was surveyed under my direction as authorized by Chuck L. Davis on behalf of the Galveston County Consolidated Drainage District, and in my capacity as Licensed State Land Surveyor for the State of Texas.

HISTORY

The Sarah McKissick Survey, Abstract 151, is a First Class Headright survey of one league of land lying in Galveston and Harris Counties. This tract was surveyed in March 1861, and reexamined and corrected September 3, 1863.

CONSTRUCTION

The elevation of the Mean High Water line of this project site was determined by establishing a temporary tide gauge at the location shown on the accompanying drawing. This gauge collected data from March 29, 2009, until April 3, 2009. The collected data was then correlated to the Control Gauge that was utilized for this project, Clear Lake, TX, National Ocean Service Station ID# 8770933. The calculated elevation was then transferred to the shoreline through the use of a surveyor's level, and then located horizontally through the use of conventional surveying methods. This report and the accompanying drawing reflect the result of this work.
