FIELD NOTES of the COASTAL BOUNDARY BETWEEN THE WEST FORK OF DOUBLE BAYOU (DOUBLE BAYOU) and the JOSHUA HARMON SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 159, CHAMBERS COUNTY, TEXAS. This COASTAL BOUNDARY is more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

ALL BEARINGS ARE LAMBERT GRID BEARINGS AND ALL COORDINATES REFER TO THE TEXAS STATE PLANE COORDINATE SYSTEM, SOUTH CENTRAL ZONE, AS DEFINED BY ARTICLE 21.071 OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES CODE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, 1927 DATUM. ALL DISTANCES ARE ACTUAL DISTANCES. REFERENCE IS MADE TO PLAT OF EVEN DATE ACCOMPANYING THIS METES AND BOUNDS DESCRIPTION. MAP ANGLE EQUALS 02° 06' 44"

BEGINNING at a point for the North point of this BOUNDARY, the East corner of a called 11.7-acre tract of land conveyed to Chambers County, Texas, by W. D. Grubbs, Jr. by deed dated April 23, 1958, and recorded in Volume 200 at Page 117 of the Deed Records of Chambers County, Texas. This BEGINNING corner is in the Northwest shoreline of the West Fork of Double Bayou and in the South line of 2.394 acre tract of land called TRACT I conveyed to George W. Hisler by Randy R. Hisler by deed dated March 8, 1995, and recorded in Volume 261 at Page 533 of the Official Public Records of Chambers County, Texas, and the Southeast line of the Joshua Harmon Survey, Abstract No. 159 and has a State Plane Coordinate Value of Y = 688,190.35 and X = 3,369,015.42.

THENCE in a Southwesterly direction with this BOUNDARY, the Northwest Shoreline of the West Fork of Double Bayou and the Southeast line of the Joshua Harmon Survey A - 159, the following courses and distances:

South 57° 25' 40" West 115.10 feet; South 48° 46' 46" West 160.15 feet; South 54° 06' 21" West 107.25 feet; South 38° 44' 21" West 92.14 feet; South 62° 06' 26" West 46.58 feet; South 38° 53' 27" West 86.67 feet; South 35° 20' 27" West 179.17 feet; South 36° 14' 42" West 42.05 feet; South 32° 51' 54" West 62.37 feet; South 32° 51' 54" West 34.08 feet; South 40° 31' 22" West 22.54 feet;

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South 34° 10' 54" West 81.91 feet; South 46° 44' 11" West 70.97 feet; South 47° 21' 23" West 51.76 feet; South 35° 42' 47" West 52.96 feet; South 43° 02' 05" West 54.18 feet;

South 71° 45' 42" West 218.44 feet to a point for the END of this BOUNDARY in the West right of way line West Bayshore Road 60 foot right of way. This ENDING point has a State Plane Coordinate Value of Y = 687,213.98 and X = 3,367,959.28.
