Description: A Coastal Boundary Survey, dated November 30 and December 1, 2015, by James M. Naismith, Licensed State Land Surveyor, delineating the line of Mean High Water, along the western shore of St. Charles Bay, being a portion of the littoral boundary of the William Lewis Survey, Abstract 96, same line being the western boundary of Submerged Land Tracts 68 and 69, situated north of Goose Island State Park, approximately 0.55 mile easterly from Park Road 13 (So. Palmetto St.) at coordinates N28°07'50" (28.130736°), W96°58'40" (96.977798°), WGS84, in Aransas County.

A Coastal Boundary Survey for the above-referenced project has been reviewed and accepted; upon completion of public notice requirements, the survey will be filed in the Texas General Land Office, Archives and Records, in accordance with provisions of the *Texas Natural Resources Code*, Chapter 33.136.

SURVEY CONTROL: Survey along the shoreline of St. Charles Bay was performed using survey grade RTK GPS base and rover: Hemisphere S320 receivers. Survey was conducted November 30 and December 1, 2015. Horizontal control for this project was based on tidal reference monument "877 4522 B" – stamped '1992 B' (Figure 2), (N=13,235,060.41, E=2,619,445.27, Z=3.3' NAVD88) and tidal reference monument "877 4513 H" (stamped '2009 4513 H') (N=13,230,063.33', E=2,604,803.14', Z= 4.5' NAVD88). Monument coordinates and elevations are based on GPS observation and OPUS solutions in the South Central Zone of the Texas Coordinate system. Datum is NAD83, US Feet. OPUS solutions for these monuments were used to adjust published values.

STATE OWNERSHIP BOUNDARY: The Reserve at St. Charles subdivision is located on the William Lewis survey (abstract 96) patented April 5, 1841. Since this land was patented post-1840, common law dictates that the state ownership boundary be located at the mean high water line (MHW). A tide gauge was installed at the job site and values were adjusted to NAVD88 by transferring elevation (OPUS) from tidal reference monument "877 4522 B" using RTK GPS. The standard method (NOAA) was used to transfer the established 19 year MHW datum from NOAA tide Station

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ID: 8774770, Rockport to the project area at St. Charles Bay using correlated tidal data. The established MHW tidal datum for tidal station ID: 8774513 Copano Bay was transferred to the project site by tying in NGS tidal reference monument "877 4513 H" (stamped '2009 4513 H') using RTK GPS. "877 4513 H" = +9.04' Copano Station Datum with an observed elevation of +4.5' NAVD88 (OPUS). MHW at Copano Bay = 5.64' Copano Station Datum. MHW at Copano Bay = 1.1' NAVD88. MHW established for this project was 1.05' NAVD88.

EXISTING FILL:

No existing artificial fill exists at the survey area. The MHW line has migrated landward as a result of erosion and is coincident with the bulkhead constructed landward of 2007 MHW in some places. 2007 MHW is documented in the official public records of Aransas County, Texas (OPRACT) in document number 289727.

FIELD NOTES of a coastal boundary survey along a portion of The Reserve at St. Charles subdivision situated on the William Lewis Survey A-96, along St. Charles Bay and adjacent to State Tracts 68 and 69, Aransas County, Texas. Property consists of a portion of Outlots 63, 64, 62 of the Lamar Townsite, as recorded in Volume 2, Page 37 of the OPRACT.

Beginning at a point on the MHW line of St. Charles adjacent to the Reserve at St. Charles Bay subdivision recorded in Volume 5, Page 332 of OPRACT (N= 13,236,978.78, E= 2,620,109.68) which is the **point of beginning**, from which tidal reference monument "877 4522 B" (Stamped '1992 B') (N= 13,235,060.41, E= 2,619,445.27) bears S 19°06'10" W a distance of 2,030.17' (730.86V) and tidal reference monument "877 4513 H" (stamped '2009 4513 H') (N= 13,230,063.33, E= 2,604,803.14) bears S 65°41'12" W a distance of 16,796.23' (6,046.64V),

thence N 41°12'52" E continuing along the vegetated MHW line of St. Charles Bay a distance of 17.41' (6.27V);
