Seamen's Bethel.---1914 D. Reached by Market St. cars, to which all lines transfer. Alight at 20th St.

Fort San Jacinto .- Situated east of the city, one mile from seawall, and at the extreme eastern end of the island.

Fort Travis .- Situated on mainland, northeast of Port Bolivar.
