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Report on survey of the shoreline boundary of a 0.483 acre tract of land out of Lot 18, Section 38, Flour Bluff & Encinal Farm & Garden Tracts, Nueces County, Texas.

This report with attached survey plat and exhibits is being submitted for the purpose of obtaining Land Office approval of the shoreline boundary between this property and State owned tract on the Cayo Del Oso, according to regulations of the Coastal Public Lands Management Act of 1973, Art. 5415 e-1, V.A.C.S.

Exhibit 1: Portion of plat of Flour Bluff & Encinal Farm & Garden Tracts recorded on January 20, 1895 in Volume A, Pages 41, 42 and 43 of Map Records of Nueces County, Texas.

Exhibit A: Portion of Oso Creek N.E., Tex 15 minute quadrangle, 1951.

Exhibit B: Portion of Sheet No. 1 of map of part of Laguna Madre State Tracts, prepared by General Land Office on November 1, 1946.

Exhibit C: Aerial photograph dated 4-27-78 to scale of 1" = 500 feet.

The location of this site is on a bay off of the main channel of the Oso and from examining the exhibits attached hereto, it is apparent that it was once a part of the Oso. This bay was created by a natural drainage channel coming into its north end, and it probably flowed to the main channel of the Oso about 2,000 feet west of this site. Sometime before 1951 a small dam was built across this natural drainage channel and the flow was slowed or stopped and at this time the whole area of the bay (marked in red on Exhibit C) has silted up and is no longer below mean high tide, and its ownership would be very difficult to establish because of the building of the dam.

On July 7, 1979, Herman Forbes, Ed McCarty and Clint Sumrall of the set General Land Office visited the site with me. We agreed that from a practical standpoint the best way to establish this shoreline would be

by using the survey line established by the developer of Lot 18 between 1946 and 1950. The present owner, Don Tatum, purchased the land to this line and all the surrounding tracts have been platted to this same line as lots in "Berlet Addition". This is the line which is shown on the accompanying plat and its relation to the first vegetation line is also shown. The elevation of the first vegetation line is 2.0 feet above M.G.V.D. and the platted line is somewhat higher.
