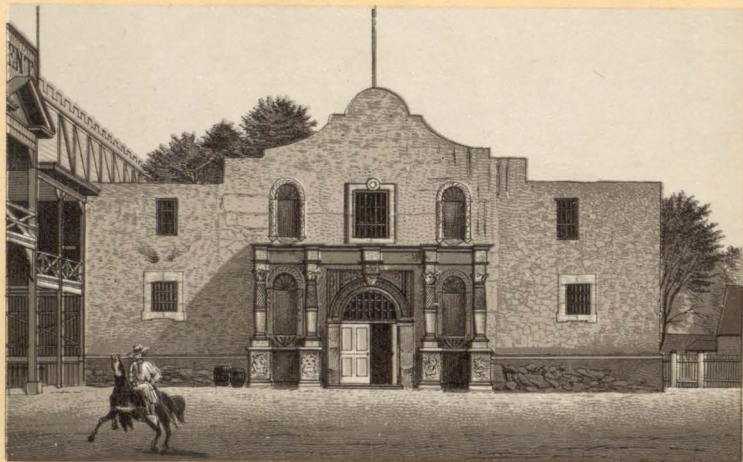

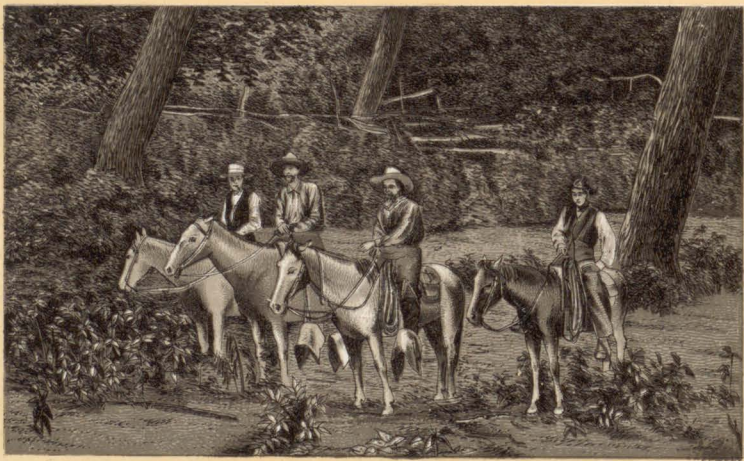

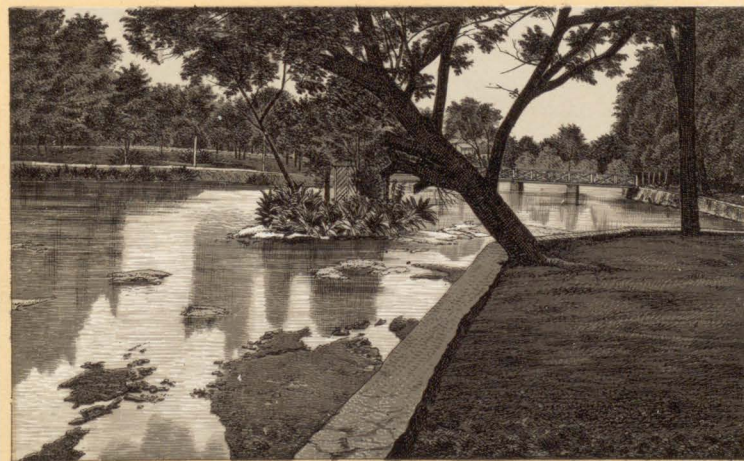

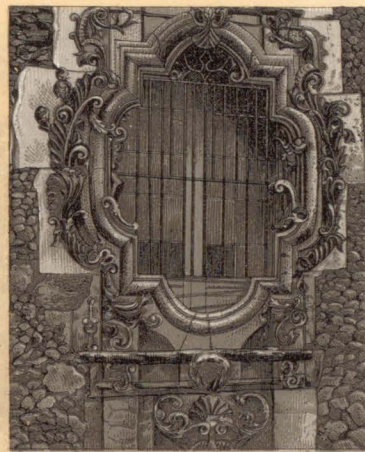




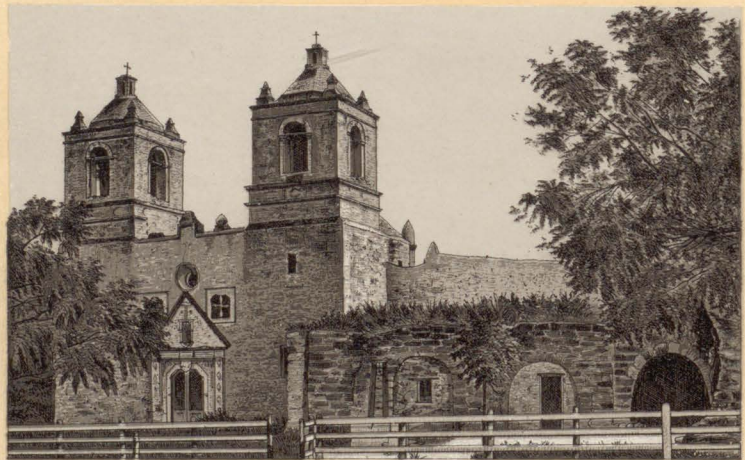

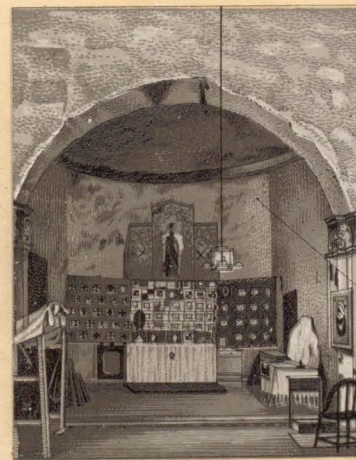

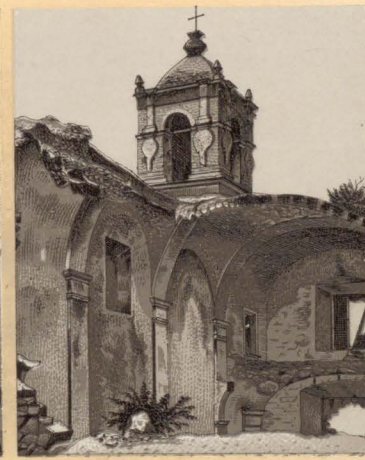

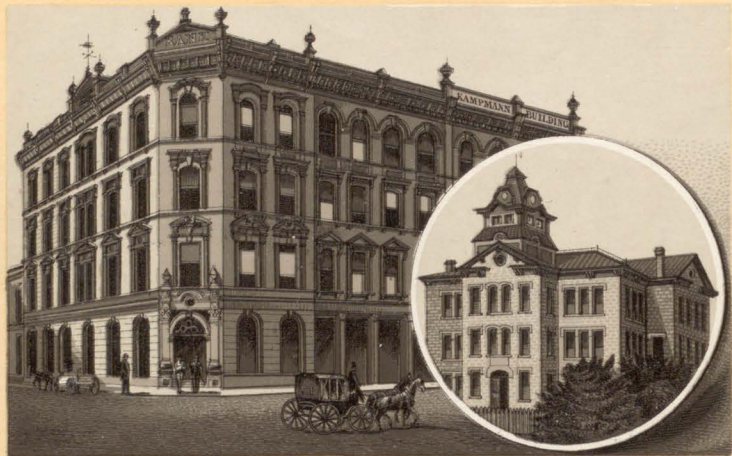

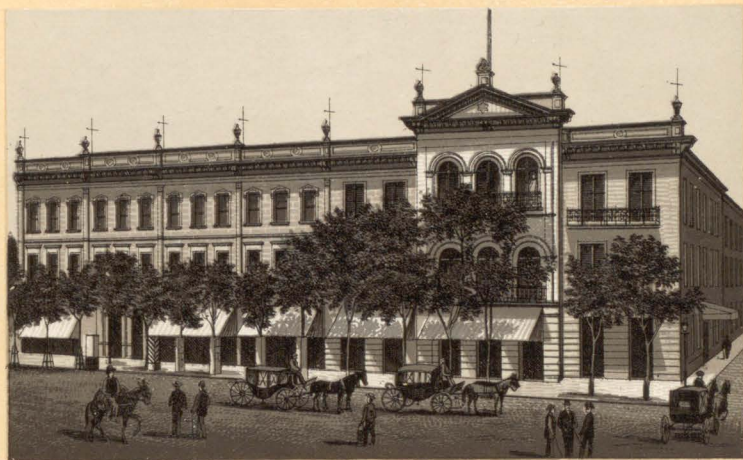

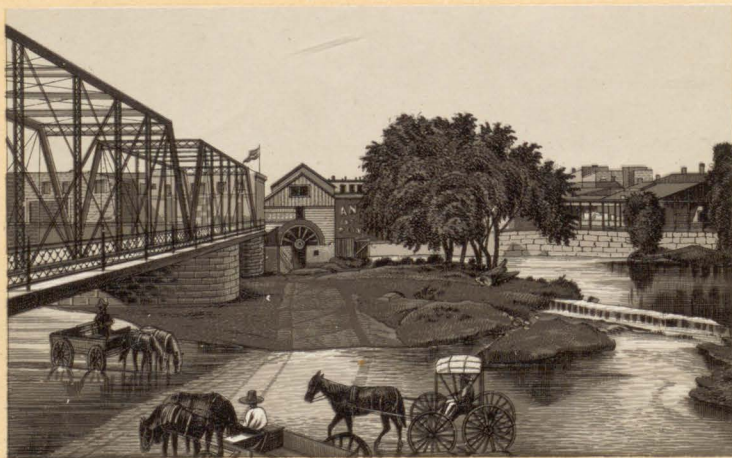

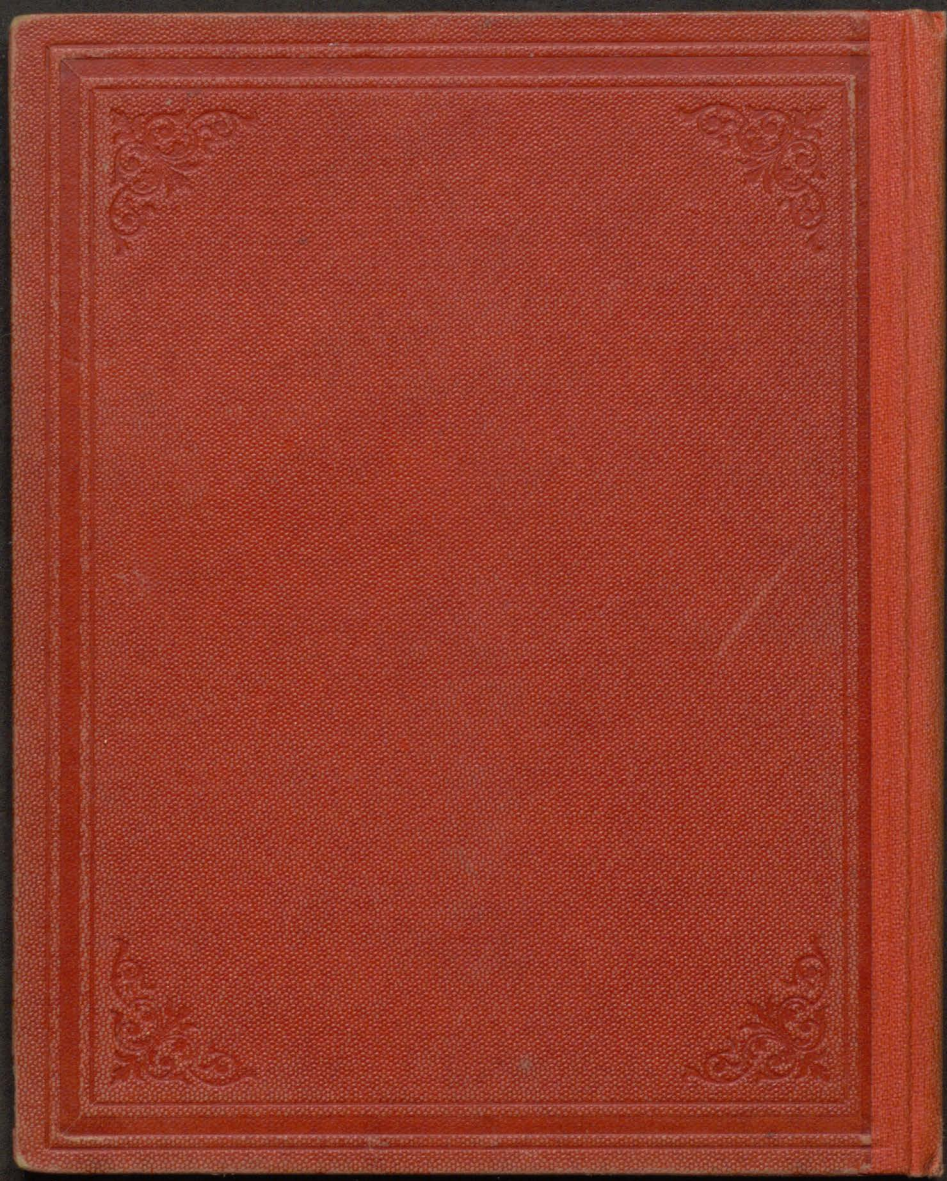

With regards to dating *Souvenir of San Antonio Texas*, I might suggest a date between 1890 and 1898, perhaps about 1895, based on the information and images it contains:

Mention of Military Headquarters of the state of Texas, which was abolished 1898

Shows San Fernando without south tower, which was built after 1902

Shows post office and courthouse building, which was built in 1887, with move-in Aug. 1890

Shows city and county hospital, cornerstone laid July 9, 1888

Mention of population est. at 45,000  
1890 census lists at 37,000+  
1900 census lists at 53,000+
