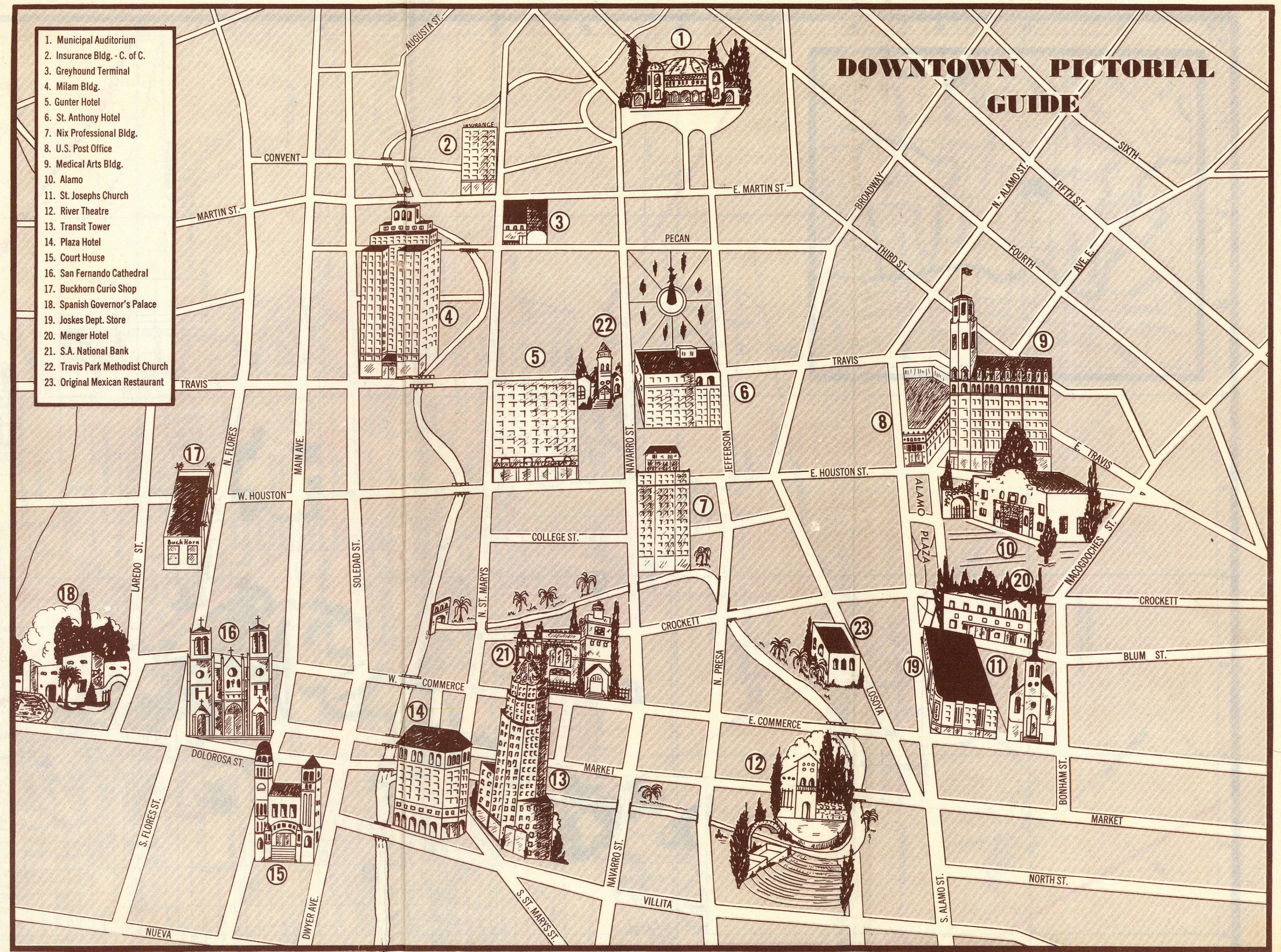

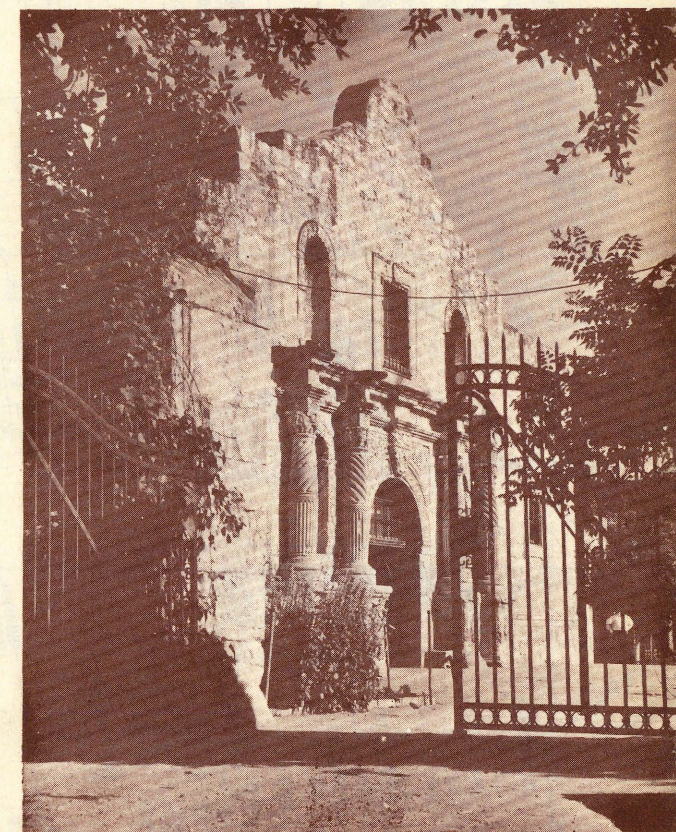
City with A Historical Past

San Antonio is one of Texas' oldest cities and third largest and the most diversified in past history and present color. Among the nation's sizable cities it is one of eight or ten which in the same sense as Boston, Charleston, New Orleans and San Francisco are wholly distinctive in their individual atmosphere. It was a Spanish outpost, then an American frontier town, a center of the American industrial and maritime trade, a resort. Metropolitan area in 1940 gave its population of 310,000. Contrary to the typical American plan San Antonio's streets branch out from the downtown area like a huge spider web.

The Missions Cathedral, Alamo and Spanish Governors Palace mark San Antonio as one of the old spots where the colorful life of the Dons once ruled suburban territory supply it with cattle, winter vegetables, citrus fruits and berries, oil, cotton and wool. These enrich its economic life.

San Antonio has the largest Army post in the United States.

It is known as the Mother-in-law of the Army because so many military men have married while in San Antonio.
