


Coastal Boundary Survey

NOTICE: This survey was performed in accordance with Section 33.136, Natural Resources Code, for the purpose of evidencing the location of the shoreline in the area depicted in this survey as that shoreline existed before commencement of erosion response activity, as required by Chapter 33, Natural Resources Code. The line depicted on this survey fixes the shoreline for the purpose of locating a shoreline boundary, subject to movement landward as provided by Section 33.136, Natural Resources

NOTE

1) All bearings, distances, and coordinates are grid and are referenced to the Texas Coordinate System, NAD 83, South Central Zone, U. S. survey feet. The mapping angle is +01°16'10" and the combined scale factor is 0.999935501 at N: 13,434,463.37' and E: 2,799,421.13'.

2) NGS Benchmark PID: ANO138 Desig: CAMPO is hereby made reference, having a State Plane Coordinate value of N: 13,433,597.26' and E: 2,815,271.85'.

3) Tide gauges 8773259 Port Lavaca and 8773701 Port O'Conner were utilized in this survey along with benchmarks 877 3259 GLO-2 and Naismith 1" Rod at site. Mean higher high water was determined to be 1.1 feet NAVD88 at project site.

4) There are two areas of fill that appear to have been made in connection with Texas General Land Office Lease# CL 2004001. The area along the northern and eastern side of the 10.26 acres, which is the western shore of Caranchua Bay has been subjected to extensive erosion since the 2012 Coastal Boundary Survey by Naismith. Part of this erosion has opened a small rivulet into the low lying part of the 10.26 acre tract between the shoreline and the eastern toe of the berm of the man made canal. The man made canal has been in existence since at least September of 1949 per Map of Boat Lot Subdivision by Robert J. Bryan, LSLS and filed in Volume Z Page 130 Map Records of Calhoun County,

5) The man made canal, berm, and Area No. 3 appear to be a remainder of Part of Fractional Section Number Nine (9) of J.D. Mitchell's Subdivision, Dedicated April 30, 1895, and filed as Map in Vol. M Pgs 446 and 447, Map Records of Calhoun County, Texas. Calhoun County Appraisal District GIS does not show ownership of the man made canal, berm, or Area No. 3.


